- 2023 Goal:
 - Recruit and diversify brokers in 4 Philadelphia Zip Codes (19140, 19133, 19134, 19120)
- Results:
 - Added 50 brokers as of 1/3/24
 - Resulting in over 430 new customers

- Applying Lessons Learned for 2024:
 - Lead the industry to gather baseline broker demographics

2024 Broker Survey

Broker Survey Results

Survey pool: 714 (61% are Pennie-certified)

Age breakout

• 71% of brokers are over 45

Experience

• 50% have at least 10 years of experience

Race/Ethnicity

- 68% Identify as White
- 7% Identify as Black
- 5.3% Identify as Hispanic

Language in which they help

- English at 97%
- Spanish 8%

Gender

- 53.5% Male
- 42.8% Female

Education

- 45% Bachelors, 17% Masters or higher
- 18% Some College, 10% Associates

Role

- 56% Independent Broker
- 18% Agency Principal
- 12% Captive/dedicated Agent

Book of Business

 32% reported 100% of business was health-insurance related

Survey Results & Market Opportunities

Target market: Philadelphia, PA 19149

Demographic	Uninsured & QHP eligible	Broker Community
African American	19.2%	7.12%
Hispanic/Latino	39.6%	5.3%
Asian/Pacific Islander	15.5%	2.48%
Age 26-34	31.1%	8.43%
Language other than English	45.2%	3.15%

62.5% of the uninsured in 19149 are Pennie eligible.



Marke Research Results

2024 Pennie Survey of PA's Uninsured

- Survey found African Americans value the importance of health coverage more than other surveyed demographics and would be motivated to shop for health coverage if they had personal help due to feeling overwhelmed in their search.
- Hispanic audiences are more likely to schedule an in-person meeting compared to other demographics.




