Open Enrollment

November 1st to January 15th



Special Enrollment

January 1st to December 31st

If you experience a **Qualifying Life Event** such as loss of health coverage, marriage, change of residence, or many others, you can enroll in a Special Enrollment Period outside of open enrollment.

What is a Qualifying Life Event?

A qualifying life event is a life-changing situation — sometimes planned, sometimes unexpected – that can impact you and your health insurance.



Loss of health coverage

Losing existing health coverage, including; Losing eligibility for Medical Assistance (Medicaid), the Children's Health Insurance Plan (CHIP), or Medicare, job-based coverage, other individual market coverage, and student plans; Turning 26 and losing coverage through a parent's or guardian's plan.



Changes in household

Getting married or divorced; Having a baby or adopting a child; Death in the family.



Changes in residence

Moving to a different service area within Pennsylvania; A permanent move from another state into Pennsylvania; A student moving to or from the place they attend school; A seasonal worker moving to or from the place they both live and work; Moving to or from a shelter or other transitional housing.



Other qualifying events

Changes in your income that affect the coverage you qualify for; Gaining membership in a federally recognized tribe or status as an Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (ANCSA) Corporation shareholder; Gaining a qualifying immigration status; Leaving incarceration (jail or prison); AmeriCorps members beginning or ending their service.
